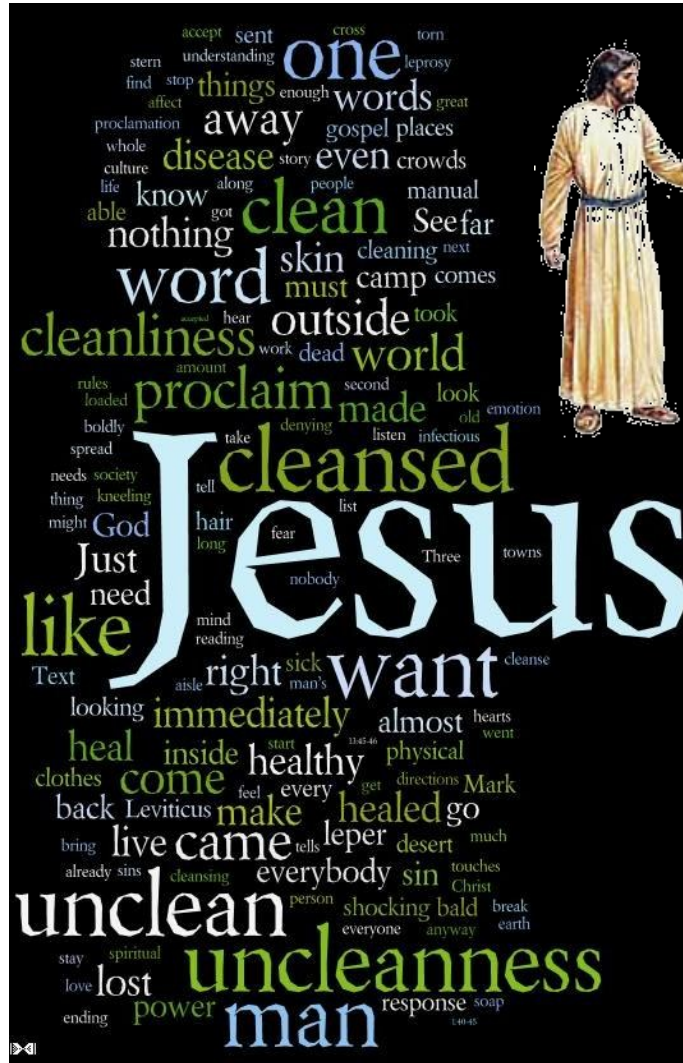

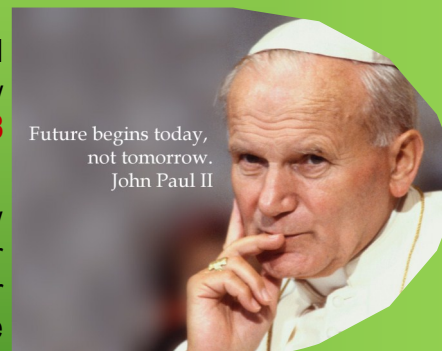

Informational Update

We continue to report positive results with the receipt of additional pledges and contributions toward our Legacy effort. Thus far, **328 families** have voluntarily participated in the Legacy initiative. Our pledge total to date is **\$ 476,325.18** with **\$ 104,466.16** actually collected.

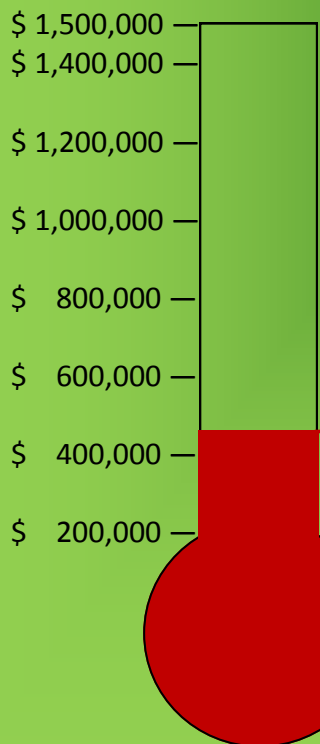


Questions continue to come to us regarding the time frame of our Legacy of Sharing initiative. Pledges and payments may be made over a three (3) year period. A longer period can be arranged if you so desire. Just indicate your desire on your pledge card or by contacting the parish office and we will arrange a payment schedule that fits your personal preference.

Once again we emphasize the need to structure your pledge commitment and payment plan so that it does not interfere with your regular weekly offertory contribution. The Legacy pledges and funds are dedicated to the specific parish needs outlined in the Legacy brochure. At the same time, it is essential for us to maintain a stable parish *operational* budget. The operational budget is designed for the purpose of paying the daily/weekly/monthly parish expenses all of which exist to provide the services that make our parish the extraordinary spiritual sanctuary it is. The funds for our operational budget come from your weekly offerings.

Federal and state laws on income and inheritance taxes encourage charitable giving. All contributions to our Legacy effort are tax deductible for those who itemize their deductions. It is particularly advantageous for some people to contribute appreciated securities, stocks, real property, or other valuables. Because every person's financial situation may yield a different benefit through diverse methods of making a gift, we recommend that you discuss your gift with your financial advisor.

For those who have not participated in the Legacy effort, pledges can be made at any time over the next three years with pledge cards available in both churches, on line at www.ifcatholics.net, or by contacting the Parish Office at 208-522-4366. Remember: every gift counts, no gift is insignificant, and every single dollar collected will be dedicated to the Legacy effort.

THE GOOD NEWS

Today's readings begin with a few verses from the book of Job. First, Job complains that his nights drag on endlessly. Then, worse yet, "My days are swifter than a weaver's shuttle; / they come to an end without hope" (Job 7:6). Not exactly encouraging, these lamentations, not when taken alone.

Most of us have been there, though, and the antidote is the "good news" that Paul found so compelling that "an obligation has been imposed on me, and woe to me if I do not preach it!" (1 Corinthians 9:16). Paul felt driven to announce the gospel to as many people as possible, "to save at least some" (9:22).

This good news is the mystery of the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ, who lifted Simon Peter's mother-in-law from her sickbed with a mere touch of his hand. "The whole town was gathered at the door. He cured many who were sick with various diseases, and he drove out many demons" (Mark 1:33-34). Our woes and demons are as real as Job's, and Jesus is our savior.

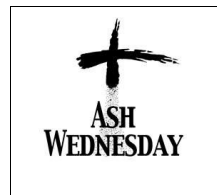

Las lecturas de hoy comienzan con unos versos del libro de Job. En primer lugar, Job se queja de que sus noches se alargan indefinidamente. Y luego, aún peor, "Mis días corren más aprisa que una lanzadera y se consumen sin esperanza" (Job 7:6). No son precisamente alentadoras estas lamentaciones, no cuando se examinan por separado.

La mayoría de nosotros ha estado allí, sin embargo, y el antídoto es la "buena noticia" que Pablo encontró tan convincente que sentía que predicarla "era su obligación. ¡Ay de mí, si no anuncio el Evangelio!" (1 Corintios 9:16). Pablo se sentía impulsado a anunciar el Evangelio a tantos como fuera posible, "para ganarlos a todos" (9:22).

Nuestros males y demonios son tan reales como los de Job, y Jesús es nuestro salvador.
