A Characteristic of Christians is how they love each other...
"Built of living Stones", (p 80)

While writing this Team Note I had an interesting conversation with Fr. Raul about what makes a church. Is it the ability of people to gather together to worship, or is it the building itself? As he and I talked I became fascinated about the theology of worship spaces. As we talked he reminded me of something which I had learned while a member of the Diocesan Liturgical Commission.

"What makes a church different from any other building is not its form or shape but rather how it facilitates for a particular community of believers a regular unfolding of the Christian mystery, the eternal divine plan for humanity as revealed in the person of Jesus Christ." (ibid, p 80)

Fr. Raul spoke to me so beautifully about how a place of worship should be built of living stones. What is unique about Christianity is that we believe through the Eucharist that we become the body of Christ. As we gather together in **one place** as **one people**, our differences fall away, and we are united in the Spirit. Our worship space is there to unite us all into that one body of Christ.

We, the people of God – we the Catholics of Idaho Falls in our baptismal call are united together. Through our sharing in the Body and Blood of Christ we proclaim the reality of being one. Through our sacraments and prayers we are in unity with the Bishop of Rome, Pope Benedict, Michael our Bishop and with our pastors as well as one another. In the celebration in the sacramental life of our parish family we recognize the need to be transformed into the image of Christ and we promise that we will do our best to conform to that image. That unity is not easy. But it is ever more possible when we strive to work together to bring about something greater than ourselves.

The Bishops of the United States remind us that the church building manifests the baptismal unity of ALL who

gather for the celebration of liturgy and convey the image of the gathered assembly. They remind us that our worship spaces (indeed all of our facilities — by extension) must facilitate the symbolic role of the Image of Christ in the unity of the people of God.

So, do our worship spaces image us as a people of God and do they do so well? Do our spaces for liturgy create a sense of a "gathering place" where all are welcome? Do our houses of God invite us to join the community, in dialogue, in worship? Do our spaces meet the needs of those who can't see, or hear or walk? When we look around are we filled with awe, that in this space, God lives among his people gathered together? Do our spaces symbolize who we are by reflecting how we behave or what we do? Can we celebrate a procession with awesome dignity during the Easter Vigil? Can we spread palms or flowers on the pilgrim way on the Feast of Corpus Christi or on Palm Sunday? Do we have a special, recognizable, place set apart for the Holy Fire to start the Easter Vigil? Do we have a place of beauty and dignity in which to pray the rosary and bask in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament? Do our cry rooms provide a special place for those who need to use them or are they just a place to which we shunt noisy families? Can we gather for coffee after Mass without trekking through the wind and the snow or the rain?

These and many other questions come to mind when we look at our facilities through the eyes of our theology and our understanding of Church.

And you what questions would you ask of your facilities? What things do you think are important for the people of God as they gather in a community of believers?

"Hecho de Piedras vivas" Conferencia

Tuve una conversación interesante con el Padre Raúl mientras escribía esta Nota acerca de lo que hace a una iglesia. ¿Es la capacidad que tienen las personas para reunirse a venerar, o es el edificio mismo? La conversación que tuvimos acerca de la teología sobre lugares de adoración fue fascinante. Él me recordó mientras hablamos de algo que aprendí cuando era miembro de la Comisión Litúrgica Diocesana.

"Lo que hace a una iglesia diferente de cualquier otro edificio no es su forma ni figura sino cómo facilita a una comunidad en particular de creyentes el despliegue regular del misterio cristiano, el plan divino eterno para la humanidad revelado en la persona de Jesucristo". ("Hecho de Piedras Vivas", P 80)

Padre Raúl habló conmigo tan hermosamente acerca de cómo un lugar de culto debe ser construido de piedras vivas. Lo extraordinario acerca de cristiandad es que creemos que por medio de la Eucaristía llegamos a ser el cuerpo de Cristo. Cuando nosotros nos reunimos en un lugar como un solo pueblo, nuestras diferencias desaparecen, y somos unidos en el Espíritu. Nuestro lugar de oración esta ahí para unimos en un solo cuerpo de Cristo.

Nosotros, el pueblo de Dios – nosotros los católicos de Idaho Falls fuimos unidos por medio de nuestro bautismo. Por nuestro compartir en el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo proclamamos la realidad de que somos uno. Estamos unidos por medio de nuestros sacramentos y las oraciones con el Obispo de Roma, Papa Benedicto, Michael nuestro Obispo y con nuestros pastores así como el uno con el otro. Reconocemos a través de la vida sacramental de nuestra familia parroquia la necesidad de ser transformados en la imagen de Cristo y prometemos que aremos lo mejor para preservar esa imagen. Esta unidad no es fácil sin embargo es siempre más posible cuando nosotros nos esforzamos por trabajar juntos para producir algo más que nosotros mismos.

Los Obispos de Estados Unidos nos recuerdan que el edificio de iglesia manifiesta la unidad bautismal de todos los que nos reunimos para la celebración de la liturgia y transmite a otros la imagen de una asamblea. Ellos nos recuerdan que nuestro lugar de oración (verdaderamente todos nuestros edificios -- por extensión) debe facilitar el papel simbólico de la Imagen de Cristo en la unidad del pueblo de Dios.

Unos pocos pensamientos para reflexionar: ¿Así que nuestro lugar de oración le muestra a los que entran al mismo que somos el pueblo de Dios seguidores de Jesucristo? ¿Crean nuestros espacios para la liturgia un sentido de un " lugar de reunión " a donde todos son bienvenidos? ¿Nos invitan la casa de Dios a unir a la comunidad, en el diálogo, en el culto, en la oración, en la celebración? ¿Satisfacen nuestros espacios las necesidades de los que no pueden ver, ni pueden oír ni pueden andar? ¿Cuándo nosotros miramos a nuestro alrededor nos llena de admiración, al ver que Dios esta entre su pueblo unido? ¿Simbolizan nuestros espacios a quién nosotros estamos reflejando cómo nosotros nos comportamos o lo que hacemos? ¿Acerca y elimina las diferencias culturales entre miembros célebres y destacados? ¿Podemos celebrar nosotros una procesión con dignidad impresionante durante la Vigilia Pascual? ¿Podemos esparcir nosotros palmas o flores como peregrinos en Corpus Christi o en el Domingo de Ramos o durante la fiesta de Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe? ¿Tenemos un lugar especial para hacer nuestra fogata del día de la Vigilia Pascual y así iniciarla? ¿Tenemos nosotros un lugar de la belleza y la dignidad para rezar el Rosario y aislarnos en la presencia del Santísimo Sacramento? ¿Tenemos un cuarto o lugar apropiado para las familias con niños pequeños en el cual puedan estar cómodos o es solo un lugar para las personas ruidosas? ¿Podemos reunirnos para el café después de Misa sin viajar arduamente por el viento y la nieve o por la lluvia?
