—Troup 310's cache cooker camp stove has been borrowed and we need it back. Please return it ASAP, thanks.

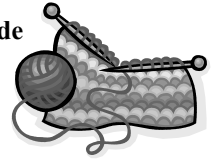

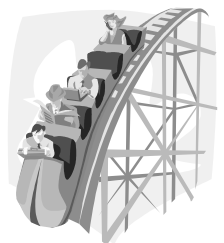
