

GUIDELINES FOR EASTERN DEANERY

1. Youth attending deanery events must be a member of the Catholic faith or sponsored by a Catholic.
2. Youth in grades 9th through 12th are eligible to attend deanery events.
3. "Returning" deanery persons involved on team must be 21 years or older if they are directly involved with deanery activities, i.e. workshops, chaperones, etc.
4. Youth are not permitted to use or have in their possession, alcohol, tobacco, or illegal drugs.
5. Any form of romantic involvement is prohibited.
6. No profanity or fighting.
7. Stealing, lying, cheating, and dishonest conduct are prohibited.
8. Youth are asked to attend the entire event!!!
 - (a) The weekends build as they progress.
 - (b) A youth may be expecting the weekend to be spiritual and only attend during he less spiritual or game times and may be "turned off" by deanery
 - (c) A youth who is just beginning to look into his/her faith and has not reached a place of being comfortable in spiritual activities may be "turned off" because he/she is only able to attend at a time that is very spiritual.
 - (d) How do you control how many can be gone at a given time? This makes planning workshops, meals, whatever almost impossible. It is not fair to those who have come for the entire event or those who have worked so hard to prepare for the event.
 - (e) The questions and reasons go on and on and on and on.....
9. Youth are not permitted to leave an event and return to said event.
10. ALL DRIVERS MUST BE 21 YEAR OF AGE!!!(Diocese of Boise rule!!)
