

Team Notes...

Over the past few weeks I have been asked by several different people what we have been doing the last 5 – 6 years to maintain the facilities at Christ the King and Holy Rosary. My response has typically been, “Well, lots of things!” But when I was asked most recently and answered, the person replied to me and said, “Why haven’t you told the community about what has been done?” This Team Note is a *belated attempt* to give all of you an idea of what has been going on with the facilities. *Please forgive me for not doing this sooner.* It will be mostly just a list because to provide full details would take several Team Notes – call me if you have questions 522-4366:

Notes: In some cases I have added approximate costs. This list is NOT complete and without going to the budget numbers from previous years the amounts are best guesses from memory. The list does not include the approximately \$35,000 spent on San Anthony’s in Roberts, Saint Ann’s in Mud Lake and Our Lady of Guadalupe in Shelley

Christ the King Parish Hall

- Painted all of the inside (\$4,500)
- Repaired heating systems (\$3,500)
- Painted parking lot stripes (\$1,500)
- Added heat tape in gutters
- Added a new sound system
- Repaired and later removed the dangerous playground equipment

- Replaced south sidewalk (\$1,500)
- Removed dead tress (\$1,700)

- Replaced carpet in 4 classrooms with tile
- Set up a new classroom in the gym
- Added water softener system to protect heating system a& kitchen equipment

Parish Office

- Painted white base of building
- Painted all handrails
- Resurfaced damaged concret
- Added new front door
- Upgraded part of the electrical system
- Painted downstairs and added carpet
- Remodeled basement to create 2 meeting rooms
- Remodeled office to create more office space – added approximately 3 new offices

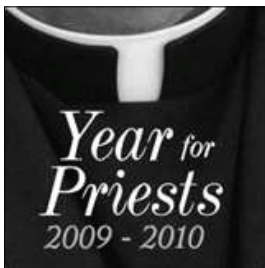
News & Notes

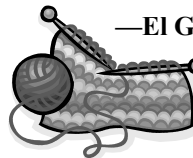

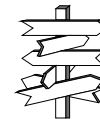
