


## Saint John Paul II Fellowship Group

We use email as our primary source of communication about planned events. We usually send out an initial email with information about the next event and then follow up with a couple of reminder emails, so you'll hear from us a few times a month.

We normally meet at a local venue (like a restaurant) in a separate space and those who attend buy their own food and beverages, but as we grow and evolve, we will expand our activities. We usually ask for RSVPs in the form of an email reply so we can let the venue know how many to expect. It also gives us a way to make sure we look for and welcome each person who attends. The RSVPs are in no way intended to discourage people from attending if they didn't get back to us. They are merely an aid to help us plan.
